

OBJECTIVES OF THE JUDGE

As the judge your main objective is to maintain law and order, secure that justice is obtained and you must remain impartial.

You are in charge of keeping the schedule of the court:

- 1) You welcome people to court and present the people present.
- 2) Opening statements of the defense and prosecution.
- 3) The public medical examination of Ed.
- 4) Witnesses testifying.
- 5) Closing statements of the defense and prosecution.
- 6) Public debate of the jury.
- 7) The sentencing.

You might want to prepare your welcome speech and look into similar cases and punishments prior to the sentencing.

Remember that defense and prosecution might object to questions that are irrelevant, speculation, or hearsay. You have the power to either overrule or sustain an objection.
